Qacha's Nek Gospel Crusade 06th – 07th February 2026

Over the past three months, the Jesus Is the Same Gospel Outreach ministry has experienced remarkable growth and impact through a series of evangelistic activities, community engagements, and prayer initiatives. This period has been marked by a strong move of God, evidenced through increased outreach efforts, deeper community connections, and a visible hunger for the Gospel across different regions. Our mission to spread the unchanging message of Jesus Christ has continued to bear fruit, with many lives touched, restored, and transformed.

A major highlight of this quarter was the powerful Gospel Crusade held in February at Melele Stadium in Qacha's Nek. The event drew an overwhelming crowd of close to 5,000 people from across the district and surrounding areas. The atmosphere was filled with worship, prayer, and the preaching of the Word, creating an environment where many encountered the presence of God in a profound way. During the altar call, a significant number of individuals responded, surrendering their lives to Jesus Christ and committing to a new walk of faith. This moment marked not just a decision, but the beginning of transformed lives and renewed purpose for many.

In addition to salvations, the crusade was accompanied by powerful testimonies of healing and deliverance. Many attendees reported experiencing physical healing, emotional restoration, and spiritual freedom during and after the services. Prayer teams ministered to individuals with various needs, and the impact of these moments continues to echo throughout the community. Local leaders and residents have since shared encouraging feedback about the noticeable positive changes in the area, including increased church attendance, unity among believers, and a growing openness to the Gospel message.

Beyond the crusade, the ministry has continued with follow-up programs to ensure that new converts are disciplined and integrated into local churches. Partnerships with church leaders in Qacha's Nek have been strengthened, allowing for ongoing mentorship, Bible study groups, and consistent spiritual support. Outreach teams have also revisited the area to reinforce the work started during the crusade, ensuring that the seeds planted continue to grow and produce lasting fruit.

Overall, this quarter has been a testament to God's faithfulness and the effectiveness of the Gospel when it is boldly proclaimed. 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Pre-Crusade Outreaches February 2026

In preparation for the Gospel Crusade held in Qacha's Nek in February, the Jesus Is the Same Gospel Outreach ministry conducted a series of focused mini-outreaches across neighboring villages, schools, taxi ranks, and other busy community areas. These outreach activities were strategically organized as a groundwork effort to promote the upcoming crusade while simultaneously spreading the Gospel on a more personal and accessible level.

Ministry teams were deployed into different locations where they engaged directly with people through street evangelism, one-on-one witnessing, and open-air preaching. At taxi ranks and marketplaces, many individuals paused to listen to the message, receive prayer, and ask questions about faith. In schools, sessions were held to encourage young people with messages centered on purpose, discipline, and hope in Christ, creating a meaningful connection with the youth. These engagements were not only impactful spiritually but also helped build trust and familiarity between the ministry and the local community.

Printed invitations and verbal announcements were shared widely, ensuring that awareness of the crusade reached as many people as possible. In addition, worship moments and short prayer gatherings were held in some areas, drawing attention and creating a spiritual atmosphere that attracted even more people. Testimonies began to emerge even before the main crusade, with individuals expressing renewed faith, encouragement, and in some cases, decisions to follow Christ during these early encounters.



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These mini-outreaches proved to be highly effective in mobilizing the community and preparing hearts for the larger gathering. Many who attended the main crusade later testified that they first heard about it during these local engagements. The initiative significantly contributed to the strong turnout at Melele Stadium and played a key role in ensuring that the impact of the crusade was both deep and far-reaching.

Overall, the pre-crusade outreach efforts were instrumental in laying a solid spiritual and relational foundation. They demonstrated the importance of meeting people where they are and reaffirmed the ministry's commitment to holistic evangelism—one that not only gathers crowds but also transforms lives at an individual level.





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Pastors Missional Workshops

As a ministry, we also actively host Pastors' Missional Workshops aimed at awakening and strengthening the vision for missions among church leaders. These workshops are designed to help pastors understand the urgent need for intentional outreach, particularly in the deep rural areas of Lesotho and beyond, where many communities remain unreached or underserved.

Through these engagements, we emphasize the biblical mandate of missions and encourage churches to move beyond traditional boundaries, embracing both local and cross-border evangelism. A key focus of the workshops is to equip pastors with practical strategies on how to identify, mentor, and mobilize young people within their congregations, preparing the next generation to carry the mission forward with passion, discipline, and spiritual maturity.

The workshops also provide a platform for collaboration, where pastors can share experiences, challenges, and best practices in ministry. This has helped to build stronger networks among church leaders, fostering unity and a shared commitment to advancing the Gospel.

We successfully conducted these workshops in Mafeteng, Maseru, Rothe, and Hlotse, where we witnessed encouraging participation and a growing hunger among pastors to engage more intentionally in missions. Many leaders expressed a renewed sense of responsibility and commitment to developing mission-oriented programs within their churches.

As a result, several churches have begun taking practical steps such as organizing local outreach initiatives, mentoring young leaders, and integrating missions teaching into their regular church activities. We continue to follow up and support these pastors to ensure that the impact of the workshops translates into sustained action on the ground.

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Schools Ministry Outreaches

As part of our ongoing outreach efforts, the ministry has been actively engaged in Schools Ministry, focusing on both high schools and primary schools. The primary objective of this initiative is to reach young people with the Gospel of Jesus Christ at an early and formative stage of their lives.

During these visits, we facilitate organized school sessions where learners are gathered and shown the film *The Jesus Film*, which clearly presents the life, ministry, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ in a way that is both engaging and easy to understand for young audiences.

Following the screening, a message of salvation is shared, giving learners the opportunity to respond to the Gospel. We have consistently witnessed a powerful response, where many—often the majority—of learners willingly make the decision to accept Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Savior. These moments are handled with care, including guided prayers, encouragement, and where possible, connection to local churches for follow-up and spiritual growth.

Our Schools Ministry also goes beyond evangelism by instilling moral values, hope, and purpose among learners. In a time where young people face increasing social and spiritual challenges, these sessions serve as a source of guidance, encouragement, and positive influence.

In each of these institutions, we received warm cooperation from school administrations and staff, enabling us to effectively carry out our programs. The openness of the schools has significantly contributed to the impact of this ministry.

As a result of these visits, many learners have taken initial steps in their faith journey, and seeds of transformation have been planted in their lives. We continue to trust God for long-term impact as these young individuals grow in their faith and become future leaders who will influence their communities positively.

We are committed to expanding this Schools Ministry to reach more schools across Lesotho and beyond, ensuring that the message of Jesus Christ continues to reach the next generation.
